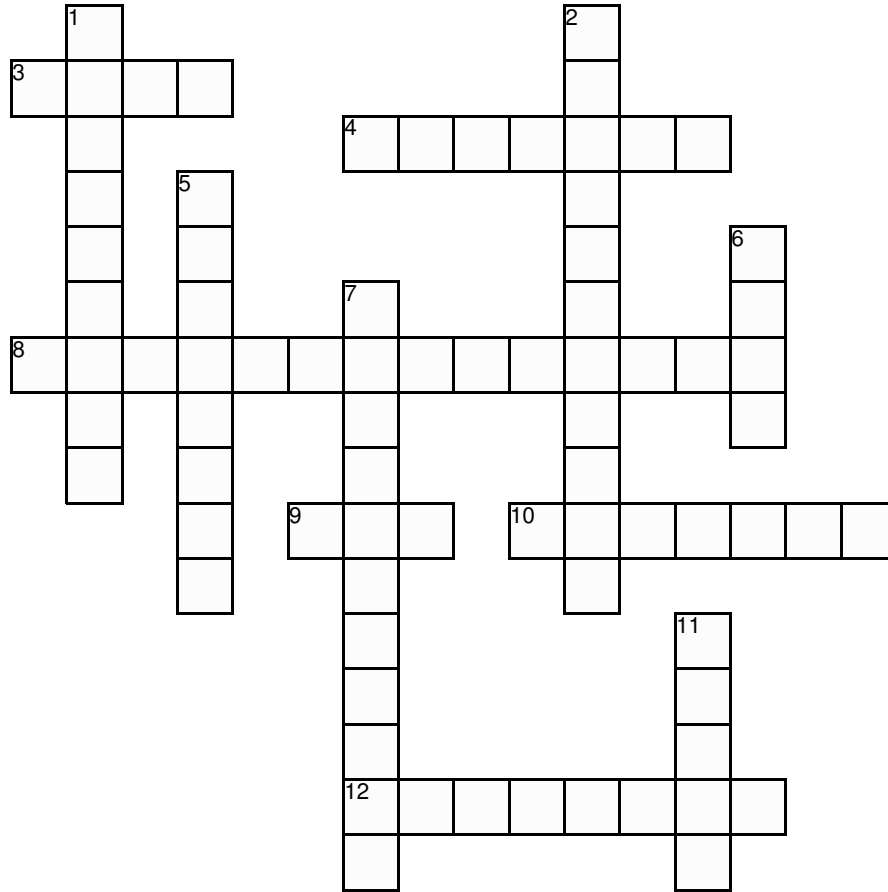


Sandwich History Crossword Puzzle
